

## ANNUAL CONGRESS of ANAESTHESIOLOGISTS Thursday 20th & Friday 21st May 2021

- 1. Eligibility Anaesthetists in Training <u>OR</u> Fellows of the College of Anaesthesiologists of Ireland (in good standing) Consultants and Non-Consultants. Medical students /Scientists with supervision in ICM / Anaesthesiology doctors are welcome to submit.
- 2. Free" means free case reports, audit or research.
- 3. Abstracts are to be submitted on the abstract form maximum 250 words. Successful poster submissions will be presented as E-Posters. E-posters should be submitted as a single slide power point presentation. (Templates are available by email from <a href="mailto:congressabstracts@coa.ie">congressabstracts@coa.ie</a> or from www.anaesthesia.ie)
- 4. Papers should not be presented outside the originating department prior to the meeting.
- 5. Presentation at the meeting. Successful candidates should make themselves available for the full 90 minutes of their allocated session to present their E-Poster on the 20th & 21st May 2021.
- 6. Presentation at the meeting. Successful candidates will be required to give a 2-3-minute oral summary of their paper at an allocated E-Poster Pod at the venue, followed by questions from the judges
- 7. The absolute time limit for receipt of **abstracts** is by **Monday 15th March 2021**. Abstracts should be emailed to <u>congressabtracts@coa.ie</u>.
- 8. The <u>absolute time limit</u> for receipt of **Final E-Posters** is <u>strictly</u> by **Monday 26th April**. Submissions must be emailed to congressabtracts@coa.ie.
- 9. Prizes will be awarded before the final key note lecture on Friday 21st May 20201.
