



Simulation and Clinical Skills Training Manager

The College of Anaesthesiologists of Ireland (CAI) is the post-graduate training body responsible for training in Anaesthesiology, Intensive Care and Pain Medicine in Ireland. The College, based in Merrion Square Dublin 2, wishes to appoint a Simulation and Clinical Skills Training Manager who will be responsible for managing the operational, technical and administrative aspects of the CAI simulation and clinical skills training programmes. The post purpose is to support the Directors of Simulation and Training, Clinical Educators and CAI staff with the development and delivery of simulation training and clinical skills events as well as to manage the day-to-day operation of the College of Anaesthesiologists Simulation Training (CAST) Centre. The appointment will be for an initial period of two years. On review, the post may be extended to a permanent position. Part time applications may be considered.

The Key Components of the role are:

- Day to day management of the Simulation Centre;
- Collaboration with the Directors of Simulation and Training in relation to the planning, development and delivery of simulation and clinical skills training programmes;
- Collaboration with the Directors of Simulation and Training in relation to the national and international promotion of CAI simulation and clinical skills training initiatives as well as the accreditation of CAI simulation and clinical skills training programmes;
- Leading the development of required operational processes and procedures for simulation;
- Assisting the Directors of Simulation and Training and other College officers in representing the CAI in simulation and clinical skills activities with outside health professionals.

The ideal candidate should have:

Experience / Qualifications Required:

- A nursing or medical science related qualification with an appropriate range of clinical skills and knowledge;
- Current registration or licensure in health profession;
- Relevant experience working in a clinical environment;

- Experience in healthcare simulation or equivalent OR a demonstrable interest and evidence of participation in healthcare education and clinical skills events.

Other desirable relevant qualifications:

- Anaesthetic, PACU, Intensive Care, Emergency Medicine graduate diploma and/or experience;
- Diplomas/degrees in Clinical education and/or simulation in healthcare and/or human factors;
- Knowledge of patient simulation services, applications and technologies.

Knowledge and Skills

- Excellent organisational, analytical and problem-solving skills;
- Effective communication and interpersonal skills;
- Strong IT skills and ability to learn quickly;
- Ability to master new equipment and software;
- Advanced audio-visual skills;
- Ability to work on own initiative;
- Strong team-working skills.
