JOIN US IN Dublin for the long awaited 5th Hands-on Faculty of Pain Medicine CAI Interventional Pain Management Cadaver Workshop on 13th November 2023 with expert lectures and hands-on cadaver training (Fluoroscopic Procedures).

This one day course will cover the current management of pain interventions within a multidisciplinary framework. The format will consist of short presentations and keynote lectures, with an extensive proportion of the time spent on cadaver demonstrations. The small number of participants per group will ensure the delivery of an individually tailored programme. Educational resources will be provided for the course.

The course is suitable for beginners and advanced practitioners in the fields of Pain Medicine and Anaesthesiology.

The delegates will benefit from a faculty assembled from many leading Pain teaching centres in Ireland. The course will take place at the Pillar Centre for Transformative Healthcare, Mater Misericordiae University Hospital, Eccles Street, Dublin 7, Ireland.

These hands-on workshop stations will include fresh frozen cadavers at the Pillar Centre facility. This course will cover:

- 1) Fluoroscopic Anatomy & Imaging for Interventional Pain Management Procedures
- 2) Advances in Interventional Pain Management
- 3) Updates on Neuromodulation

- X-ray Guided Procedures
- Radiofrequency Ablation – lumbar
- Nerve Root Blocks – lumbar
- Neuromodulation (Spinal Cord Stimulation/Peripheral Nerve Stimulation)

- Genicular / Hip Interventions
- Sacroiliac – simplicity/ Palisade/ intra-articular Interventions
- Radiofrequency Ablation – cervical
- Nerve Root Blocks – cervical
- Sacroiliac – Cooled Radiofrequency, intra articular Interventions
- Racz/ Pelvic interventions
- Lumbar sympathetic/splanchnic Interventions
- Disc/Lumbar Interventions
- Trigeminal/ Sphenopalatine/Stellate Ganglion Interventions
- Lumbar Facets Radiofrequency Ablation
- Cervical Radiofrequency Ablation
- Cervical Nerve Root Blocks/stellate
